Brussels train station is located 25 minutes by bus from the BEL Conference center

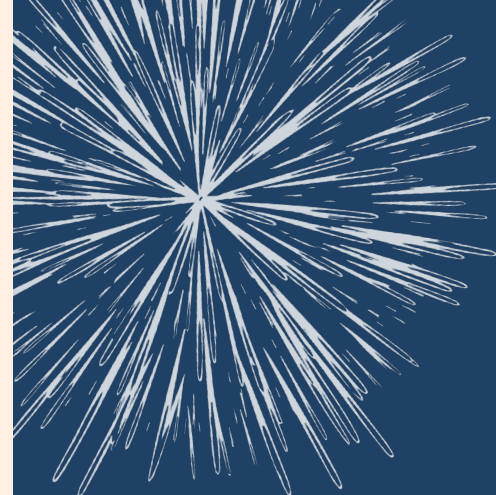
- By plane :

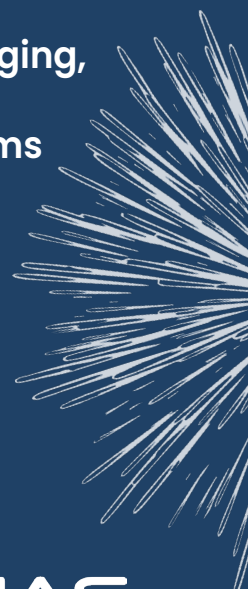
